Online Beneficiary Designation

Important Note before you begin: If you are married, your spouse must be designated as your sole beneficiary to complete your election online. If you choose to designate someone other than your spouse, please visit Plan Information > Forms and Forms on the participant website to download a paper copy of the form.

- Step 1 After logging in to your account, select **Go to My Account**.
- Step 2 Under the Personal Information menu, go to Beneficiary Information and Add/ Edit Beneficiary.
- Step 3 Confirm your Marital Status. Then click Next. Enter the requested information. Items marked with an asterisk (*) are required. If married, to enter information online, your spouse must be your sole beneficiary. If married and you want someone other than you spouse as sole beneficiary, you must fill out a paper beneficiary form located in the Forms section.
- Step 4 Here you can Add Beneficiary/Change Information/or Remove old information.

 Note: If adding a new beneficiary you will need their Social Security number,
 Date of Birth, mailing address, and the percentage you would like them to receive.
 Once you make your changes click on Submit.
- Step 5 When you have entered all desired beneficiary/contingent beneficiary information, be sure to click **Save**.
- Step 6 You are now ready to submit your Beneficiary designation(s). When complete, you will see a confirmation screen with your beneficiary designation(s).
